Coaches Report:

The sled has arrived.

The new sectional has been released. The teams comprising our sectional are: FC, Evansville North, Castle, and Bedford. We will stay in this sectional for the next two years.

Player meetings will begin Thursdays, May 21st after school until 3PM to prepare for next year Monday May 18th will be a meeting at lunch with 8th graders who will be playing football next year. The middle school meeting took place on the 29th.
