

FC Booster Club Meeting – September 1, 2015

Introduction and Welcome to the Meeting

Minutes from July, 2015 approved.

Treasurer's Report:

7 on 7 concessions; Used leftover food to feed the boys and the items were used for other purposes. Lots of drinks were left from the donations.

Shirts are done. A few more deposits are left. We did HHMS shirts this year as well. We should make about \$8,300 profit on the shirts. This is about \$450 less than last year but cost was higher and we are not selling at the games. If we can find someone to sell at the games, we could make some more. She has a small stock that we can sell through word of mouth.

Beef O'Bradys made \$410.00 to be deposited.

Senior Banners will be ahead and we will use those funds to provide the seniors with a Tshirt. Karen is working on this.

Karen will make some "Line up" Shirts and her logo on the back to throw out at the games to throw in the crowd. We'd like to see if the freshman could wear a uniform and throw into the student section and maybe players could throw to adults to the adult section. Coach has approved this. No cost to us as Karen Nifong will sponsor this.

Middle School Dinners funds will not cover the expenses needed. Janet will be making a list of those that have not paid.

Coaches Report:

Powerades have not been billed yet. It will be about \$800.00. It may have been paid out of athletics so we will have to transfer to cover. Coach will find out. We should be good on powerades for a while.

Important dates: This week, team meal after school on Friday. Be there at 2:25p to feed the boys. This will be done again for Columbus East. We may have more for sectional. Football pays for all that food.

Fall Break will be here soon. The two Mondays, Oct 5 and Oct 12, there is no school but there will be team building activities. On Oct 5 will be community service for set up for Harvest Homecoming. Then, the Booster Club provides lunch of some sort. Harvest Homecoming provided lunch on that day last year so it may happen again. That approximate time is about 11:30a or noon. We will need volunteers for this. We use the room behind the PTO because they are cleaning the cafeteria. On October 12, boys will go bowling and they will need a lunch about 11:30a or noon. We will need to provide food and have volunteers to serve it. We will still have Thursday dinner those weeks. Kellie and Shelly will work on Fall Break dinners. She will reserve the room for serving.

Labor Day practice will be 8a until 11a for just sophmores, juniors, and seniors.

Prize distribution will be during study table.

Total players are 29 freshman + 56 (soph, juniors, seniors) + 3 managers + several trainers.

Committee Updates:

- 1) Merchandizing – 2 outstanding orders to deliver. The only issue has been the ink has not stuck as well. Adidas ink has not been as good.
- 2) Thursday Dinners – Shelley Polk
- 3) Locker Clean up – Kim Sans and Lori Savage – cleaning supplies are covered. We may need a shop vac. Janet will check to see as they may have a spare one.
- 4) Line Sponsors – Janet Philpot – made \$130 with no cost.
- 5) Turkey Bowl Concessions – (run the concessions/get volunteers)
- 6) Kroger Cards – Jimmy Polk - \$248 was from 2 months ago. We need to have folks re-register to get the credits.
- 7) Away Game Meals – Kellie Carl – she has this covered for this week.
- 8) Youth Football – Stan Taylor – 4 games in and going well. We are checking into possible Horseshoe foundation. We still need \$8000 to finish off the replacement of helmets.
- 9) Banquet – Carrie Stiller and Kellie Carl – no news to report.
- 10) All Sports Banquet - unsure if this will happen.
- 11) Middle School – Kim Moon – They are also in the same situation with helmets as far as needing to upgrade helmets as well. Jimmy will follow up with them.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) Locker room – no floor drains so that might be a problem for rubberizing.
- 2) The 9/11 game will have special events. Coyle Chevrolet will let us use the flag. We need to check with ROTC about rolling the flag process. We will put out an email to have any first responders on the field and all the details about what is needed. It has also been put into the newspaper already.
- 3) Flash store – Only about 10 people ordered so very little profit was made on this. We have another plan to consider for next year that Coach has in mind.
- 4) Grades – end of period is Friday, October 2. Letters were sent home yesterday if there was any player with a D or F on their progress report. Parents have to sign and return to Coach. They must pass 5 classes. Fall Break has intercession to help kids get their grades up.
- 5) Jersey -they will be making the purchase for new ones for next year. This will be a cost that will need to be shared with Coach's fund and the Booster Club. The jerseys are just done. Each jersey will cost about \$100 and will need home and away so cost will probably be about \$20,000.00. It will be more if new pants are needed. Seniors have the option to buy their jersey at the end of the season for \$50.
- 6) Music really electrified the stadium and made the game so much fun.
